Introduction of course:

This summer SAT preparation course provides a thorough preparation of the SAT (Reading/Writing and Math). Through the course, students will get a comprehensive understanding of the SAT and be familiar with the types of questions, learn the test-taking strategies, increase their test taking accuracy and speed as well.

The workshop meets for eight weeks. On Mondays (9AM-12PM) students will take 1 in-class proctored full SAT practice test (real SAT test), where classes follow the exact script, timing, and limited break-times of the official SAT test. On Wednesdays (9AM-10:30AM), the instructor will review and explain the most missed/requested problems from the practice test taken on Monday, including thorough analysis of the missed problems, so that students can understand where they are struggling and create goals for the next test they take.
